Your brand new state of the art, purpose built Community Centre is now ready and waiting to greet you and we look forward to seeing anyone who cares to drop in to enjoy a chat and a brew in our cosy lounge from June 21st, when the Covid restrictions will hopefully have been relaxed.



We will be delighted to give you a tour of the new building which includes a large multi purpose hall that can be divided into two sizeable areas and a smaller hall ideal for meetings, training and other class sized group events. A well equipped kitchen, a bar, office and toilets complete the facilities which are designed to make the Community Centre suitable for almost any occasion including public meetings, theatrical performances and private functions.
