The Cellar Bar is now set up for functions.



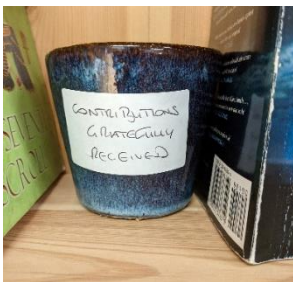
We have already hosted a 40th wedding anniversary, a celebration of life, a 19th birthday party - and lots of lovely children's parties.
